The following materials should be included in the application email.

1. Personal Information: This should include the applicant's name, affiliation/faculty, and contact information.
2. A copy of the abstract submitted to PHONONS2010.
3. A short personal statement that must address the following points (1 to 2 sentences for each item is sufficient):
 - A. Explain your role in the research project.
 - B. At what stage are you of your undergraduate or graduate education/program?
 - C. Why is it important for you to get a subsidy to attend the PHONONS2010 Conference?
4. A reference letter from the student's advisor, in a separate file.
